# Numeracy



The children will be learning about Area and Perimeter. They will be calculating the area of regular, irregular and compound shapes. We will recap finding the area by counting squares and then learn to use the formula Length x Breadth. This topic requires sound table knowledge so please continue to help/encourage your child to learn them.

In the final weeks of term, we will begin our topic of fractions and the children will be covering work on finding a fraction of an

amount and equivalent fractions. This can be a difficult topic and the children may require further explanation. Let us know if we can help your child further.

# Shared Reading/ICT

We are still reading our class novel, 'Giant' by Kate Scott.

Approaching Christmas, we will read about the Birth of Jesus and will make a powerpoint presentation based on this special story.

We will also be practising our skills using Microsoft Office and Powerpoint.


