LITERACY

Creative writing: We will be writing a letter to the prime minister persuading the government to import more Fairtrade goods to the UK.

Reading: All groups are working hard on their reading- keep it up. Please come prepared to school on your reading day. Encourage your child to adopt a love for reading. They should be reading their Accelerated Reading book at home and completing their quiz in school.

Shared Reading: We are working hard to finish our Viking class novel Grim Gruesome.

Talking & Listening: Your child will take part in a Fairtrade debate before the end of term. They will be asked to take on the role of one of the major stakeholders involved in Fairtrade and work with a partner to present their side of the argument.

NUMERACY

Decimals

We will be learning about decimals. Pupils must have good knowledge of Place Value and understand that the tenths column is tenths (1/10) and links to fractions.

Ten tenths = 1 unit.

We will be learning to add/subtract/multiply & divide decimals.

Negative numbers

We will be learning where negative numbers are used eg)

Thermometer, lift, sea levels, bank accounts etc. We will be learning how to add and subtract involving negative numbers.

Eg) $3 - 7 = -4$

Percentages

Children should understand the relationship between percentages, decimals and fractions.

Eg) $25\% = 0.25 = \frac{1}{4}$, $10\% = 0.1 = \frac{1}{10}$

(A table of all these facts is in the Spellings & Tables jotter)

They will be learning how to find a percentage of a quantity

eg) 50% of 500, 25% of 100, 10% of 1000.

(This will also allow us to revise division)

They will be learning how to calculate percentage increase and decrease.

Eg) 10% off in a sale. How much does the item cost now?
