#### School Enrolment

Recently, office staff attended awareness training for the new 'Digital Admissions' to Nursery & Primary One. The admissions 'portal' has now been developed and is found on eani.org.uk/parents/admissions. Applications can be made from Wednesday 2 January 2019 until Thursday 31 January 2019. This means parents making the application directly to EA, without involvement of school. School has updated admissions criteria and sent back to EA. The onus will very much be on parents to ensure they initiate the procedure. School will provide support, where possible.
