STEP 1: Go to www.easyfundraising.org.uk, register your name and select 'Ebrington Primary School-Londonderry' as your chosen school to support.

STEP 2: When you shop online use the easyfundraising website first. Click on the retailer that you want to shop with and choose whatever you would like to buy. The price of the item(s) is exactly the same as if you'd visited the retailer directly.

STEP 3: After you have been shopping and made your purchases, the retailer will donate a percentage of the sale to Ebrington PS as a thank you for shopping with them.

STEP 4: It doesn't cost you anything extra. It is the retailer that pays the donation to our school.

STEP 5: Happy Shopping!

School Enrolment

Information on the procedures for school admissions in September 2021 should be available on the EA website eani.org.uk/parents/admissions mid- December 2020 for Pre-school/Primary 1 places and for post-primary places (Year 8 entry). This means parents making the application directly to EA, without involvement of school, for Nursery and Year 1. School are currently updating criteria to send back to EA for Nursery and Year 1 admissions. The dates given for the application process for primary and nursery schools currently is that it will go live on the EA website on the 7 January 2021, with a closing date for applications on 29 January 2021.

PTA Events

PTA fundraising events will look very different this year, due to covid-19. We are very unlikely to be able to run any of our previous events in the same way. School Cashless System

However, this week, there have been a large number of phone calls needing made by the office staff to remind parents to book the dinners. Both paying and FSM pupils need to have the dinner booked on the system before 11:59pm on the day before it is required.

We hope to be in a position to operate our ASC service for P1 & P2 pupils soon, Monday-Thursday, where the option is there to stay on until 3:00pm at a cost of £2.50. We know, having surveyed these parents in September, this would be something that would be very much appreciated at this time.

We had planned to have this in place in October but, unfortunately at that time, we had 13 staff off and a number of bubble closures and we simply were not in a position to proceed. Obviously, if a similar scenario were to develop this half-term, we may find it impossible to operate. We thank you for your consideration and patience with this.
